

## Crocheted Weighted Companion Cube

Using 3.00m crochet hook and 8ply acrylic yarn.

### Hearts (Make 6) using pale pink

### Grey backing circles (Make 6) using pale grey

row 1 – ch2. 10 dc into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook. Sl to join

row 2 – ch2, dc into same stitch. 2dc into each stitch around. Sl to join. Fasten off

### Light Grey corners (Make 8)

- 1) start with a magic circle. ch1 and sc 6 times into ring. Sl st to join.
- 2) ch1, \*sc into next st, 2sc into next\* repeat twice. Sl st to join.
- 3) ch1, (sc, 3sc, sc) around (15 sts). Sl to join.
- 4) ch1, (sc, sc, 3sc, sc, sc) around (21 sts). Sl st to join.
- 5) ch1, (sc, sc, sc, 3sc, sc, sc, sc) around (27 sts). Sl st to join.
- 6) Ch1, (sc, sc, sc, 2hdc, sc, 2hdc, sc, sc, sc) around (33 sts). Sl st to join
- 7) Ch1, skip one st, sl st into next, \*sc, hdc, 2hdc, hdc, 2hdc, hdc, sc \*, sl st into next 4. Repeat from \* to \*. Sl st into next 4. Repeat from \* to \*. Sl into next 2. Fasten off. (Leave a long tail as you can use this to attach this piece to the main cube).

Crease along points of triangle to form corner shape.



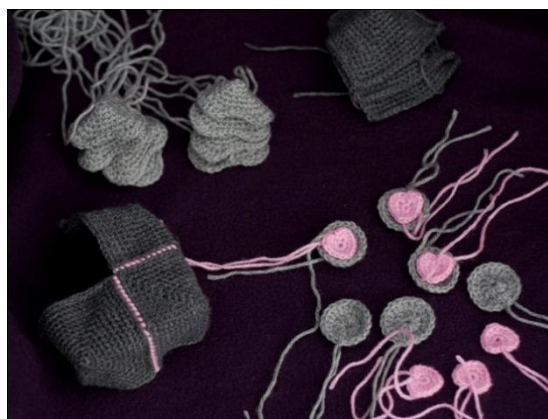
### Dark Grey corners (make 8)

- 1) start with a magic circle. ch1 and sc 6 times into ring. Sl st to join.
  - 2) ch1, \*sc into next st, 2sc into next\* repeat twice. Sl st to join.
  - 3) ch1, (sc, 3sc, sc) around (15 sts). Sl to join.
  - 4) ch1, (sc, sc, 3sc, sc, sc) around (21 sts). Sl st to join.
  - 5) ch1, (sc, sc, sc, 3sc, sc, sc, sc) around (27 sts). Sl st to join.
  - 6) Ch1, (sc into next 4, 3sc in next, sc into next 4) around (33 sts). Sl st to join.
  - 7) Ch1, (sc into next 5, 3sc in next, sc into next 5) around (39 sts). Sl st to join.
  - 8) Ch1, (sc into next 6, 3sc in next, sc into next 6) around (45 sts). Sl st to join.
  - 9) Ch1, (sc into next 7, 3sc in next, sc into next 7) around (51 sts). Sl st to join.
  - 10) Ch1, (sc into next 8, 3sc in next, sc into next 8) around (57 sts). Sl st to join.
  - 11) Ch1, (sc into next 9, 3sc in next, sc into next 9) around (63 sts). Sl st to join.
  - 12) Ch1, (sc into next 10, 3sc in next, sc into next 10) around (69 sts). Sl st to join.
- Fasten off and weave in ends.  
Crease along centre of each side of "triangle"



### Light grey edges (Make 12)

- 1) Ch 4, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each remaining ch (3 ch total)
  - 2) Ch1 to turn. Sc in each stitch.
  - 3) Ch1 to turn. Sc in each stitch.
  - 4) Ch1 to turn. Sc in each stitch.
  - 5) Ch1 to turn. Sc in each stitch.
  - 6) Sc evenly all around the piece.
- Fasten off, leaving a long tail.



## Putting it all together

- 1) Sew dark grey corners together using pale pink wool. Seam is worked through the back loops of the sc edges of the dark grey pieces. Seam is intentionally left visible.



- 2) Sew the other pieces on. Each face of the cube should look as follows:



- 3) Stitch it all up piece by piece, leaving an opening for stuffing.



- 4) Stuff (don't over stuff as you want the cube to remain cube shaped rather than spherical. Stitch up and sew on last heart.
